MEDICAL	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. UNIS Communication.</li> <li>2. Set-up an emergency plan and a board to delegate tasks for any disaster.</li> <li>3. Train and practice the emergency plan.</li> <li>4. Educate the community through a medical summit.</li> </ol>
PRIVATE BUSINESS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Review the Standard Operational Plan with supervisor and staff and coordinate with other branches.</li> <li>2. Contact state, federal agencies, association, neutral businesses and associates for advice, directions and funding.</li> <li>3. Develop and create a disaster team with in each business.</li> </ol>
FAITH-BASED	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Join LEPC.</li> <li>2. Work with the county.</li> <li>3. Prepare families.</li> <li>4. Educate the community.</li> </ol>
EDUCATION	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Utah State University will include in their family consumer science program a family preparedness certification to include pandemic educational module.</li> <li>2. In the monthly mailers, (bills, grocery sacks, etc), a preparedness tip will be included.</li> </ol>
ELECTED OFFICIALS	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Work with legislator, community, and citizens to make services available.</li> <li>2. In the bill a quarterly newsletter will be sent to the city and county that will include preparedness tips.</li> <li>3. Coordinate flu care facility to include use of the correctional facility.</li> </ol>

2. Establishing a Triage meeting with medical personal
